### **Toward a New Moral Contract: Reclaiming Trust in Public Service**

**Currently:** Senior Research Fellow, Faculty of Social Sciences, University of Ottawa and Senior Fellow, Massey College, University of Toronto

**Distinguished career:** Vice-President of the Public Service Human Resources Management Agency and head of the Office of Public Service Values and Ethics, 2003 to 2006.

- Responsible for development and passage of the Public Servants Disclosure Protection Act, unanimously approved by Parliament in 2005.

- Treasury Board of Canada Secretariat, Assistant Secretary 1998-2003.

Responsible for coordination of an integrity and accountability package for the Government of Canada, including a Values and Ethics Code for the Public Service and a Management Accountability Framework (MAF). He also served as the founding chair of the Public Sector Service Delivery Council, and launched both the Service Canada and Service Improvement initiatives.

- 1990 to 1998: faculty member of the Canadian Centre for Management Development. During this time he served as Vice-Chair of the Task Force on Public Service Values and Ethics, and as Associate Constitutional Advisor to the Special Joint Committee of the Senate and House of Commons on a Renewed Canada. He also created the action research program on Citizen-Centred Service Delivery, which won the IPAC Gold Award for innovative management in 1999, and the CAPAM Silver Award for innovation in 2000.
