The Information and Privacy Commissioner is an independent officer of the Saskatchewan Legislative Assembly. He oversees three different Saskatchewan statutes.

The OIPC has jurisdiction over Saskatchewan departments; Crown Corporations; provincial agencies; health regions; universities, colleges and schools; municipalities; health information trustees such as physicians, pharmacies, laboratories, diagnostic clinics, and a number of other organizations. The OIPC has no authority over the federal government or the private sector other than private businesses that are health information “trustees”.
